The invoice/statement you will receive confirming your reservation is an agreement between Inspiration Cruises & Tours, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as ICT) and the passenger. Travel dates include sailing days only; air travel and forced overnight hotels are additional. **All prices, payments, penalties and change fees are quoted per passenger** based on double occupancy (two persons per room). Sites, artists, speakers and/or schedules are subject to change. 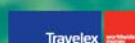

However, depending upon the strength of the U.S. Dollar and the fluctuating nature of fuel and other taxes, published prices are subject to change without notice and will be chargeable to the passenger up to the time of departure.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICES: Passport costs; transit to/from pier, travel to/from the departure city; pre/post hotels; items of a personal nature including, but not limited to, laundry, room service at hotels, meals in transit, phone calls, etc.

When necessary, a group visa for U.S. citizens will be obtained for those confirmed by the final payment date. **Travelers originating from outside the U.S.** also need a valid passport, and should consult their country's embassy regarding specific requirements for entry into each and every country of destination. Your passport name must match the name on your cruise reservation and airline/cruiseline ticket or you may be denied boarding.
